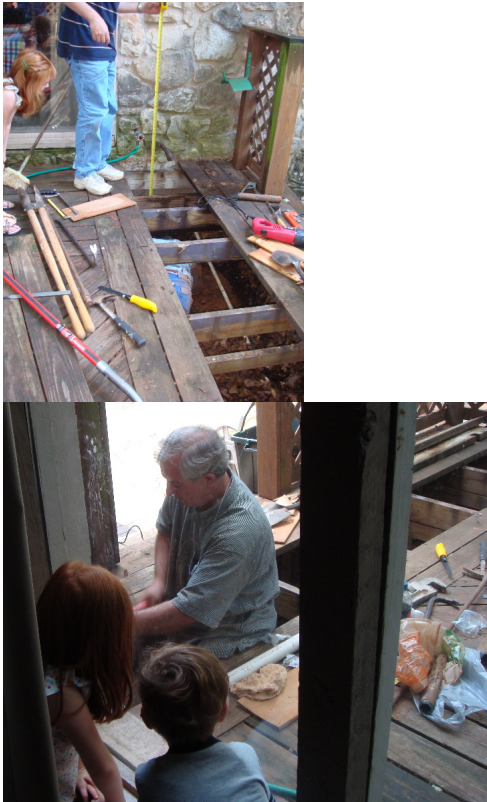


Gas Leak
