

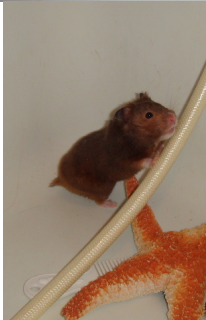
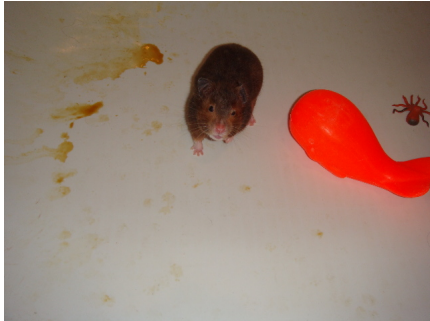
Castle Cutie's Escapade
