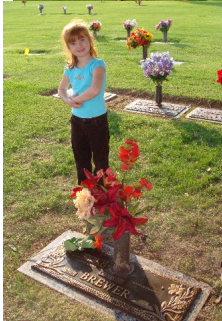


Visiting Nana's Grave
